[PPE Conservation guidelines \(CDC\)](#)

- **Epi report:** food production (vegetable processing plants, farms, factories) is driver outbreaks. Also seen fishing industry outbreaks. Not a lot of childcare/education outbreaks right now, but most are still closed. PPE conservation measures have been re-aligned to CDC guidelines. Not seen increase in rates due to protests.
- **Follow up from Gov. proclamation re: non-urgent procedures:** Re: temp and symptom screening- may assess upon arrival or via confirmation that they self-assessed prior to arrival.
- **Questions and discussion re: allowing students and volunteers back into hospital setting:** Most not returning volunteers, very challenging and many are high-risk. Some allowing students in capacities that won't burn PPE.
- **WA health updates:** Demo of the WA Health website.
