Student Poster Contest

Theme: “Plant Hope, Grow Resilience”

Description: Olympic Community of Health is hosting a poster contest through January 5, 2021 to encourage hope and resilience during COVID-19. Students in kindergarten-12th grade who reside in the Olympic region (Clallam, Jefferson, or Kitsap Counties) are invited to submit poster designs inspired by the theme “**Plant Hope, Grow Resilience**”. Show off what hope looks like to you and your community. Submitted posters will be shared with communities across the Olympic region to encourage hope and resilience during these difficult times.

Prize: Three winners will be chosen, one from each county. **A prize of \$100 gift card will be awarded to each winner.** Winners will be announced on January 12, 2021.

Contest Rules/Qualifications:

- Poster submissions must be created by a student, kindergarten-12th grade
- Submission must include completed entry form (found on page 2)
- Posters must be 8.5x11” and submitted electronically via email (amy@olympicch.org) or mailed to PO Box #641 Port Townsend, WA 98368
- Artists must reside in the Olympic region (Clallam, Jefferson, or Kitsap Counties, or one of the seven sovereign Tribal nations)
- Poster imagery must relate to the theme “Plant Hope, Grow Resilience”
- The poster must be an original work of art by the student
- Only one entry per student
- Posters must be submitted by Jan 5, 2021 deadline
